

Report on application of UDC Classification in Czechia

It is well known that UDC classification scheme is widely used among libraries in Czechia. The UDC classification scheme forms part of the main subject organization tool - Czech Subject Authority File consisting of/created by three subfiles: topical, geographical, and genre/form.



Czech UDC Online – České MDT online

The most important prerequisite for the use of the classification system in current information environment is its online availability.

Since 2015, the Czech MDT Online has been operating on the Consortium UDC Hub platform as a free service for Czech librarians, library schools and researchers





Users' statistics on the Czech MDT Online in 2017 and 2018:

In 2017 there were total of 1,101 individual user accounts, in 2018 1,454 user accounts.

Further indicators of the usage (monthly number of queries) shows an average of 9.841 accesses per month in 2017 and 10,943 accesses in 2018



1. Progress on updating MRF 11 in Slovak authority system

The work on updating the UDC classification system – MRF 11 in the Slovak authority system is still in progress. We still have problems allocating staff to this activity due to the ongoing project of the digitization of Slovak cultural heritage. The whole process of updating MRF 11, being very demanding, is expected to be completed during 2019. Currently, the status of the update is as follows:

Slovak UDC Online (Slovak MDT Online)

Nowadays the service Slovak MDT Online (http://sk.udc-hub.com/sk/login.php) enables access to 505 librarians from all types of libraries, students, researchers from Slovakia, but we also have users from Czech Republic, Serbia and Poland.

Our support still has a few problems with forgotten passwords. Following our last year's advice users are nowadays emailing us requesting password reset, rather than filling in another registration application. Clearly the user management system requires upgrade to alleviate this problem. The best solution for Slovak MDT is upgrading to a system where only one account is registered by library with a contact person for each library as has been implemented for the Croatian UDC Online.

Regarding the Slovak MDT Online we plan other activities in 2019 including training workshops for UDC users. Before the release of MRF12 we plan to publish information about a new MRF version and the differences between last and latest MRF in library journals and other communication channels. We will also distribute information about the new model of registration upon its implementation in MDT Online. The completion of the Slovak translation and release of MRF12 is a pre-requisite for our planned training activities. These are organized in conjunction with regular annual events of National Bibliography of SNL called "Bibliographic days" that take place in Martin, Bratislava and Prešov (Central, Western and Eastern Slovakia).

Users' statistics on the Slovak MDT Online:

Although the number of user accounts is 505 (before 467), they usage of the systems is very significant with 20,984 queries per month. Compared to last year, we have a slight increase from 18,728 to 20,984 queries per month.

VINITI RAS (Russian Academy of Science)

VINITI RAS continues to maintain and update the Russian-language version of the UDC tables and UDC editorials team is in the process of preparing the next issue of changes and additions (corrections & extensions) to the Russian edition of the UDC tables. Specialists in VINITI RAS continue to work towards the integration of various classification schemes and maintain (and update) the original "System of classification schemes", which makes semantic connections between the UDC classes and the national classification of GRNTI (State Scientific and Technical Information Classifier).

VINITI RAS is actively promoting the UDC use in neighbouring countries. Libraries in the Republic of Kazakhstan have recently completely switched to the use of UDC tables.

Aenor

P. Jiménez reported on sales statistics and further stated that the abridged edition, due to its low price, is very popular among students. AENOR is expecting some increase in the sale of CDU Online Español in 2019, planning a discount for Latin America. The service is trying to find a publisher for an abridged edition in Argentina and is collaborating with the National Library of Spain in the MRF12 translation. The release of MRF12 in the Spanish Online edition is planned before summer 2019.

Slovenian National Library

I.Sešek reported on the work starting on the MRF12 translation and plan for the MRF12 release in the Slovenian UDC online service. Libraries are requested to provide UDC numbers in the process of cataloguing (from the set of 1000 UDC numbers). They expect an increase in school libraries using the service. In collaboration with the UDC editor-in-chief the National library plans a workshop on UDC in September 2019.

National and University Library in Zagreb

National Library reported on the increase in use of the Croatian UDC Online service and efforts the Library puts towards supporting users, in terms of guidelines and a UDC Authority File ready to be released.

National Szechenyi Library

A. Hajdu-Barát provided an update on the work taking place in the National Szechenyi Library currently focused on publishing a subject authority file containing UDC data linked to their thesaurus. They opted for the linked data infrastructure, and for UDC the UDC numbers will depend on the UDC namespace. They are currently aligning MRF12 with the old UDC data and are preparing translation work.

National Library of Poland

Jolanta Hys from the National Library of Poland reported on a remarkable level of support that UDC editorial team provides to UDC users as well as their efforts in publishing both Polish UDC Online as well as an abridged UDC edition in 2019.

National Library of Serbia

Stevanović provided an overview of the steps they undertaken to proceed with the Consortium membership and UDC translation. She described a recently initiated project of the UDC translation into the Serbian language and the enthusiasm with which the voluntary work was embraced by around 30 librarians from several large libraries in Serbia. They all attended a January workshop on UDC revision and translation delivered in Belgrade by A. Slavic which kick-started the translation work.

In the discussions that followed, members reported on shared issues with respect to UDC use in their countries caused by the lack of funding for professional work and training that leads to a decrease of numbers in UDC experts and a reliance on voluntary work. M. Balíková pointed out that there is an urgent need to promote UDC on all levels in both libraries and library schools in Czechia. These seems to be pervasive issues in other countries as well. A. Hajdu-Barát pointed out that in Hungary there is a lack of training in classification in library schools and a lack of transfer of expertise from the older to new generation of librarians. She pointed out that in Hungary also libraries expect everything to be provided by the national library. She agrees that there is a need to motivate libraries to learn and pass

on expert knowledge on UDC. Due to low salaries in libraries the most talented students from library schools choose to seek work in the private sector. G. Riesthuis added that in the Netherlands public libraries have all professionally prepared data provided for them and cataloguing is done centrally. However, there has recently been a request for formalized training/schooling of public librarians.
